Greetings,

On behalf of **Michigan Electric Transmission Company ("METC")**, a subsidiary of ITC Holdings Corp. ("ITC"), you are invited to attend an upcoming Community Listening Session in your area occurring **October 5 - October 22, 2026**, to learn more about the Copperton Projects. The Copperton Projects are 3 new electric transmission lines proposed for construction in Michigan, spanning from Mason County to Midland County and south to Gratiot County (depicted below). METC is currently evaluating a route segment network in a route study as it prepares to file an application requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity from the Michigan Public Service Commission ("MPSC"). METC extends an invitation to property owners located within one mile of a route segment or its right-of-way, as well as those situated between route segments, to attend the Community Listening Sessions.

The Projects are part of a larger Long Range Transmission Planning effort coordinated by the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. (MISO), the regional system-planning organization, to maintain the long-term stability of the electric grid and respond to the changing energy landscape in Michigan. The Projects are critical to the future grid resiliency of the region.

Our records indicate that you are listed as a taxpayer of record for the above-referenced property, which is located on or near a preliminary route segment under consideration for the Copperton Projects.

The **enclosed map shows the route segment network**. At this stage, we are gathering input from the community and stakeholders to help us evaluate and refine preliminary route networks. Additional opportunities to provide input will follow before our application is submitted to the Michigan Public Service Commission in approximately Q2 2028.

The Community Listening Sessions will be held at the locations and times listed on the back. Light refreshments will be provided.

What are the Community Listening Sessions? The Community Listening Sessions are the second phase of METC’s multiphase public and community engagement process, where the community can learn more about the Projects, ask questions, and share feedback directly with METC. You will also be able to review the route network. The Community Listening Sessions will be “open house” style, meaning the project team will be available throughout the event to discuss routing, design, construction, and other project details. Light refreshments will be provided.

At the Community Listening Sessions, you will be able to leave feedback for METC’s review, consideration, and potential integration to the route segment network. METC is seeking information concerning the following topics: (i) characteristics about your property, (ii) the activities and land uses that occur at your property, (iii) any features of historical or environmental significance, and (iv) any other information you believe will aid METC in its development of the Projects. mifuturegrid.com/copperton-projects/. Following Community Listening Sessions, there will be two more phases of public engagement, where the community can provide input on METC’s route options.

The meetings will be an open-house style format, where you can drop in any time during the hours listed on the back of this letter. No formal presentation will be given, so feel free to come and participate as you are able. These events will offer you the opportunity to learn more about the Projects, meet in person with project staff and provide your input in the early planning stages of the Projects.

Your input is important and we look forward to meeting you at one of the upcoming Community Listening Sessions.
