

District Forester Provides Free Landowner Assistance

The Forestry Assistance Program (FAP) of the Montcalm Conservation District provides in-office and on-site technical assistance to county landowners at no charge and may include:

- Identification of forest diseases and insects and their control options,
- Advice on the selection and planting of trees and shrubs for reforestation, windbreaks, and wildlife habitat enhancement,
- Information on state and federal forestry cost-share and tax incentive programs, and
- Recommendations for improving woodlots for timber production, wildlife habitat or recreation.
