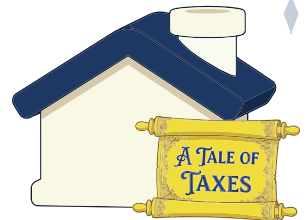

	Montcalm Community College	2.6044	Operating, capital, workforce development, and community/student support
	ISD Allocation	0.1695	Administrative special education and vocational to local school districts
	Special Education (ISD)	3.4078	Tailored instruction for children (0-26) who require specialized support
County	Montcalm County Ambulance	0.7000	Emergency medical services
	Montcalm County Library	0.8623	Operations and programs
	Montcalm County Commission on Aging	0.4400	Promote independence, dignity and well-being; (60+)
	Montcalm County MSU-4H	0.1955	Hands-on programs (5-19); skills in leadership, STEM, agriculture, and healthy living

HOW YOUR TAX IS CALCULATED - No Exemptions (Non-Homesteaded)

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Taxable Value		Total Millage		Mill Conversion		Calculation		Admin Fee (1%)		Annual Property Tax
\$100,000		9.2116 + 31.6716 = 40.8832 mills		(1 mill = \$1 per \$1,000 of taxable value)		\$100K X 40.8832 ÷ 1,000 = \$4,088.32		\$4,088.32 X .01 = \$40.88		\$4,088.32 + \$40.88 = \$4,129.20
